- Caulk, seal, and weatherstrip cracks and openings along doors and windows.

- Invest \$100 in a home energy audit to identify additional energy saving opportunities.

- Make sure your attic, walls, and crawl space are insulated to appropriate levels.
- Replace old appliances with ENERGY STAR™ appliances.
- Install a tankless water heater.
